Attendance Certificates

Congratulations to all the children that received a certificate for getting a 96% or above attendance score for our second Autumn term.! It is a fantastic achievement!

Attendance at school is a legal requirement but coming to school is about the fun of learning new skills and learning how to get on with others and enjoying all that school offers.

Days missed, means children get behind with learning but also miss out on building friendships and growing in confidence. Unless children have a very high temperature, are vomiting or have diarrhoea, please send them in after giving calpol at home. We will send your child home if they are ill.

School starts at 8:40, late arrival after the registers close at 9:30 means your child receives an unauthorised absence mark for the entire morning. Frequent lateness can add up to a considerable amount of learning lost and can seriously disadvantage your child.

A reminder that if your child is absent from school, you must call the office before 9am to let us know the reason. A call must be made to the office each day your child is off.

We cannot authorise any absences in term time. Please arrange holidays during those times that school is closed. We suggest you make a plan with relatives or friends to care for your children in case you need to travel abroad to see family who are ill. Please try and avoid taking your child out of school for any reason. Please make appointments for the dentist and doctor after the end of the school day.
