

<u>Psalm 23</u>


The Lord is my shepherd, he gives me everything I need. He lets me lie down safely in green meadows and leads me beside peaceful streams.

Goodness and mercy will follow me all the days of my life. I will make my home in the house of the Lord, my God, forever and ever.





Help us to reflect and take the time to think about all the things are going well in our lives.


