Learning Challenges

Engage

We will be learning all about how the children have changed and grown since they were babies. They will look at photos of themselves as babies and photos of them now. We will hot seat an adult with a doll as a baby and find out what babies need and why they are special.

Develop

To continue with our learning journey, we will use the text Guess How Much I Love You by Sam McBratney. The children will answer questions 'Who do you love?' 'How much?' We will use technology to draw a picture of someone they love.

We will explore how brilliant our bodies are by moving in a variety of different ways. We will find out about our similarities and differences by comparing height, hand and feet size, eye and hair colour and birthdays.

Learning Challenges

Innovate

We will look at photos of the children's families together. The children will describe who they can see, what they do, what they like to do with them, and how they make them feel special?

The children will then make a picture frame for their family photos. They will be able to choose from a variety of arts and crafts and mark making materials to decorate their frame.

Express

The children will decorate paper bags with drawings of their family and put inside heart shaped oatmeal cookies that they have made. We will discuss what love looks like and what love does. The children will be encouraged to respond by making marks and adults will help scribe their ideas. These can be added as gift tags to the paper bags.

We will be using our Noticing skills to look closely at, ourselves, our family and friends to find out who makes us happy.

Persevering

The Persevering Pirates will be helping us to learn how to 'try, try and try again'.

Collaborating

Collaborating Colin will help us to develop our collaborating skills when working and playing with our friends.

Love - we will be thinking about who we love, how we show it, who loves us, why they love us and how we know they love us. We will be looking at stories from the bible to help us understand more about what it means and how we can develop this value within ourselves.
