# Successful Learners Areas of Learning

<u>As historians</u> we will be studying life during the Vikings and Anglo-Saxon times. We will look at how they raided and traded with Britain.


As scientists we will recognise that living things can be grouped in a variety of different ways. We will explore and use classification keys to identify and name living things in their local and wider environment. We will also recognise that environments can change and that this can sometimes be a problem.

<u>As mathematicians</u> we will deepen our understanding of place value with numbers up to thousands. We will solve problems linked to addition and subtraction using written and mental calculations. We will also learn our times tables.

<u>As geographers</u> we will locate places and routes on a map where the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings came from and recognise place names.

In PSHE we will look at our feelings and the impact on others, making links with the zones of regulation. We will try to understand why we might be feeling this way and think about how we can get out of different zones.

We will persevere as we learn our next steps in our year group skills, especially with times tables and spellings.

## Successful Learners Areas of Learning

As readers and writers, we will continue to develop our comprehension and vocabulary in all areas of reading and writing in a range of genres both fiction and non-fiction. We will study the novel 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes.

<u>As information technologists</u> we will learn to programme instructions for a computer using Purple Mash. We will use the computer/iPad to research and present our learning.

In <u>Religious Education</u> we will be exploring the story of David and his strengths and qualities. We will read some Psalms to discover more about the nature of God. We will look at Harvest and how our school's values can link with it

In PE (Physical Education) we will practise our ball skills when learning how to play hockey. We will dribble and pass the ball, working as a team to defend and attack.

<u>In music</u> we will be working with Mr Hallighan to shape composition, considering dynamics, timbre and tempo.
