

We were so impressed with all the facts and their stage presence!



Get help to buy food and milk



What is Healthy Start?

If you're more than 10 weeks pregnant or have a child under 4, you may be entitled to get help to buy healthy food and milk.

If you're eligible, you'll be sent a Healthy Start card with money on it that you can use in some UK shops. We'll add your benefit onto this card every 4 weeks.

You can use your card to buy:

- plain liquid cow's milk
 - fresh, frozen, and tinned fruit and vegetables
 - fresh, dried, and tinned pulses
 - infant formula milk based on cow's milk
- You can also use your card to collect:
- Healthy Start vitamins - these support you during pregnancy and breastfeeding

Use your amazing creativity to design a sp'egg'tacular Easter Egg and be the lucky winner of one of our fantastic Easter prizes!


For £1.00 you can buy a template Easter Egg sheet from your class teacher. This competition is open to everyone! Ask people in your family to have a go!
