### Year 2 Summer Term Learning Challenge 2021

### Successful Learners

Areas of Learning

<u>As geographers</u> we will learn to locate and name the world's five oceans. We will use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to the key physical features including: beach, cliff, coast, the sea and oceans.

### As historians.

<u>As scientists</u> we will identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic and glass for particular uses. We will find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.

<u>As mathematicians</u> we will be learning to multiply and divide numbers. We will begin learning about fractionsrecognising halves and quarters. We will find half of shapes and numbers.

<u>As readers we will</u> be focusing on developing the speed of our reading and recognising alternative sounds. We will consider characters feelings and how these can change throughout a story.

#### Successful Learners

<u>As writers</u> we will be considering how to extend our sentences using conjunctions. We will be exploring more suffixes and learning how they can change the meaning of a word.

<u>As artists</u> we will be using collage to make sea animals.

<u>As design technologists</u> we will explore and use mechanisms in their products.

<u>As information technologists</u> we will be learning about spreadsheets. We will learn how to use a spreadsheet and how formulas can be made to help with calculations in a spreadsheet.

<u>As musicians</u> we will be singing together. We will listen to the sounds of the sea and consider how these sounds might inspire a piece of music.

In <u>Religious Education</u> we will be considering why the church is a special place for Christians. We will learn about and explore other places of worship and consider what makes them special too.

We will be continuing to develop our resilience and reflectiveness this half term. We will continue to persevere when our learning is challenging. We will work on improving our empathy and listening skills to make sure that we are always ready to learn in the classroom. Managing our distractions is important in year 2 and we continue improving our ability to concentrate for longer and focusing on our learning.
