


Year 5 Spring 2 2024 Learning Challenge

<p>Areas of Learning</p> <p>As Mathematicians we will be focusing on decimals, percentages and fractions. We will be looking at the relationship between them and how they are equivalent. We will be looking at numbers up to 3 decimal places and ordering and comparing them. We will then be moving onto looking at perimeter and area of a variety of different shapes.</p> <p>As Geographers we will use the 4 figure grid references in order to communicate knowledge of the United Kingdom. We will identify and describe how the physical features affect the human activity within a location. We will collect and analyse statistics in order to draw conclusions about a location. We will describe how geographical regions are interdependent and interconnected.</p> <p>In R.E We will retell the Easter Story in detail and talk with understanding about the Christian belief that Jesus died and rose victoriously and what that means to Christians. We will explain why Christians believe Jesus' death and resurrection is a victory. We will use the messages from the Gospel to find out about the importance of Courage, how we can demonstrate this value and explore how it is encouraged within other faiths.</p> <p><i>For I can do everything through Christ, who gives me strength." Philippians 4:13</i></p> </div>		<p>Areas of Learning</p> <p>As writers we will continue to use the text Skellig to help us explore author intent, how poetry can be used to create imagery and using characters experiences to learn how to write a persuasive letter. We will continue to develop our writing skills by learning how to use adverbials, modal verbs and parentheses.</p> <p>As Readers we will continue to read and discuss an increasingly wide range of fiction, poetry, plays, non-fiction and reference or text books and read books that are structured in different ways and read for a range of purposes. We will recommend books that we have read to our peers, giving reasons for our choices</p> <p>As scientists we will be looking at properties and changes of materials. We will be performing a variety of different experiments looking at how objects dissolve, filtering substances and evaporations. For these experiments, we will be showing how to plan a fair test and to interpret the results from these tests.</p> <p>In computing we will be continuing our work on coding and looking at how to code and make our own game.</p> <p>In PE we will be continuing on our weekly swimming lessons and we will be continuing our development on our invasion games skills and increasing our understanding around tactics for attacking and defending.</p>

<p>We will be focusing on building Collaboration and understanding the importance of skills like turn-taking, sharing responsibility and listening to each other. We will relate these skills to all the learning we are doing and learn the importance of being able to assess our own progress in these Building Learning Powers.</p>
