Where do you think it lives? What do you think it eats? Make a poster to show me all about it! You can use your imagination!	Have a look on Google Earth to find where Beatrix Potter lived in the Lake District. She lived in a place called Hill Top Farm in the Lake District. Does this look like Hyde? Write 3 things that re the same and 3 things that re different.
