Most sessions cost just £1.35 and are artist-led and drop-in unless stated otherwise. The sessions will take place on the following dates:

- Tuesday 8th of April 2025 Fluffy Spring Lambs - Create adorable woolly Spring lamb decorations. We'll be using recycled cardboard and soft, colourful yarn to bring these charming little lambs to life.
- Thursday 10th of April 2025 Pom Pom Pea Pods - Print your own cardboard pea pod and then create adoráble, tactile pompom peas from upcycled yarn to tuck inside.
- Tuesday 15th of April 2025 Spring Pop Up Garden - Work together and be inspired by the museum's beautiful wharf and canal outside when creating your very own instant paper pop up
- Wednesday 16th April 2025 Easter Bonnet Workshop - Create an Eggtastic Easter bonnet or hat whilst you hop around the museum. Free and
- Thursday 17th April 2025 Wax Resist Easter Eggs - Let's get crackin' with this fab Easter based craft. Taking inspiration from our collection and local textile factory 'ABC Wax' children will learn the basics of the textiles technique batik and wax resist, when building a paper plate nest, filled bright wax resist eggs.

The sessions will run 11.00 am to 3.00 pm each day.
