Areas of Learning


<u>As Mathematicians</u> we wil add and subtract 4 digit numbers and complete multi-step addition and subtraction problems. We will use rounding to estimate. We will interpret charts, line graphs, tables and timetables. We will look at multiples, factors, prime numbers, square and cube numbers.


<u>As geographers</u> we will understand key aspects of physical geography including biomes and climate zones. We will create maps of locations identifying patterns such as climate zones. We will understand some of the reasons for geographical similarities and differences between countries.

In R.E we will know that there are significant women in the Bible who made incredible choices that have an impact on God's big story. We will know that worship can be expressed in a variety of ways including prayer, dance, compassion and self sacrifice. We will know that sometimes people of faith face great challenges and remain true to their faith. We will be able to make links between our own values and the values of others.

<u>As musicians</u> we will improvise and notate musical phrases to develop compositions. We will maintain our own part in a performance with confidence, accuracy and an awarenesss of what others are playing.

This term in school we are exploring the value of Compassion.

Compassion- We will study the bible to find out about compassion and then we will remember to show compassion to others.

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As writers we will be studying different books and writing our own narrative from these as well as other genres. We will study author's skills and techniques and use this information to improve our own writing. We will focus on authorial intent and vocabulary choices as well as looking at how to create atmosphere through setting descriptions.

As Readers we will continue to read and discuss an increasingly wide range of fiction, poetry, plays, non-fiction and reference or text books and read books that are structured in different ways and read for a range of purposes. We will recommend books that we have read to our peers, giving reasons for our choices As scientists we will use secondary sources to help create a model e.g. role play or using balls, to show the movement of the Earth around the Sun and the Moon around the Earth. We will use secondary sources to help make a model to show why day and night occur We will research time zones We will consider the views of scientists in the past and evidence used to deduce shapes and movements of the Earth, Moon and planets before space travel.

<u>In PSHE</u> we will understand that there are different types of bullying and reasons why people bully each other.

Building Learning Powers

We will be focusing on building **Resilience** and understanding the importance of skills like persevering with challenges without giving up, noticing patterns and being absorbed in the task. We will relate these skills to all the learning we are doing and learn the importance of being able to assess our own progress in these Building Learning Powers.
