Inter school tournaments and competitions	£600	For all KS2 children to take part in inter school sporting events
Wellbeing learning and awareness raising events events eg Fun, Friends and Fitness;	£1500	To provide experience/taster sessions of different sports/physical fitness plus nutritional and first aid guidance To deliver effective sessions for support mental health for all pupils
