Successful Learners Areas of Learning

As historians we will be observing and handling evidence to ask questions and find answers to questions about the past. We will be using artefacts, pictures, stories and online sources to find out about the Battle of Hastings. We will describe this historical event and learn about why it was so significant to British history.

As scientists we will be learning about 'Uses of everyday materials.' We will be exploring materials, describing their properties and learning to classify them.

As mathematicians we will be mastering our addition and subtraction by applying these skills to solve problems. We will beginning to use multiplication and division and also using these operations to problem solve. We will begin learning about money, handling money and the different coins.

As readers we will begin focusing on Year 2 spelling patterns and common exception words. We will learn to read prefixes and suffixes and explore how they change the meaning of words.

As design technologists we will be examining existing product and designing new improved products to replace these. We will make our products and then reflect upon their success.

<u>As information technologists</u> we will be learning about spreadsheets. How to build them, use them and what they are used for in the working world.

<u>As musicians</u> we will be listening to traditional medieval folk music and exploring rhythm using drums.

In <u>Religious Education</u> we will be learning about Jesus and how he is a friend to everyone. We will look at Jesus' life and how we learn my lessons from his actions and the stories he told. We will explore the word miracle.

Building Learning Powers-Resilience

We will be focusing on Reciprocity. We will aim to become more aware of our own strengths and weaknesses. We will learn to accept what areas of learning we find more challenging and aim to become better learners. We will begin being learning ambassadors to support our peers where we can offer support and equally receive support thankfully when needed.

Welcome back after the Christmas break. Following a STEM week next week (Jan 17^{th}), we will be learning all about the Battle of Hastings and William the Conqueror. This is going to be an exciting History based learning challenge which I hope will excite the children.
