Areas of Learning

As information technologists we will learn how to stay safe on the internet and log on to Purple Mash using the iPads. We will learn what an avatar is and how that can keep us safe. As Musicians we will be describing the sounds from a fire. We will also be singing songs linked to The Great Fire of London and songs linked to our science learning. In Religious Education we will be comparing what the world was like for Jesus and how it is

the same and different to our

world today.
