Successful Learners Areas of Learning

As historians we will be studying the Vikings and making links with our Anglo-Saxon learning. We will look at the important events during their time here. We will research using a range of sources to present our learning.

As scientists we will complete learning linked to sound. How do we hear things? What sounds can we recognise? How does sound travel and how can we record sound? We will complete practical investigations to research this.

As mathematicians we will practise our times tables (including the inverse facts) and try and improve our speed of recall. We will be learning about decimals and money and making links between the two.

<u>In PSHE</u> we will be looking at how we can look after our mind and bodies.

<u>In D&T</u> we will be using the TASC wheel to help us research, plan, make Viking amulets to sell to our parents.

As information technologists we will learn to use the chrome books to use the 2Logo programme to create instructions for an onscreen turtle to give commands.

In <u>Religious Education</u> we will deepen our understanding of the gospel and what kind of world Jesus wanted us to live in.

In PE (Physical Education) we will learn how to be successful gymnasts. We will set up and use our apparatus equipment safely and know how to move around the hall to practise our balancing, travelling and movement.

<u>In music</u> we will link our learning to science and sound.
