#### Successful Learners

#### Areas of Learning

<u>As Mathematicians</u> we will solve problems that involve fractions. We will order, compare and round decimals. We will understand percentages as fractions and decimals. We will study equivalent fractions, percentages and decimals.

As Historians we will use sources of evidence to deduce information about the past. We will compare some of the times studied with those of other areas of interest around the world. We will describe the social, ethnic. cultural or religious diversity of past society. We will describe the characteristic features of the past, including ideas, beliefs, attitudes and experiences of men, women and children. In R.E we will know that the Book of Acts records the actions of what happened after Pentecost. We will know that the early Christians were persecuted for over 300 years and had to show great courage and perseverance. We will know that St Paul is a significant person in the history of Christianity and why. We will be able to talk about what we have learnt and in what ways we have been inspired by our learning. As Artists we will use a sketch book that includes flaps and explain how an idea has developed over time. We will combine a range of media within a piece of work for a desired effect. We will explain how a piece of artwork makes us feel, explaining our views by referencing effects.

We will be focusing on building **Resilience** and understanding the importance of skills like persevering with challenges without giving up, noticing patterns and being absorbed in the task. We will relate these skills to all the learning we are doing and learn the importance of being able to assess our own progress in these Building Learning Powers.

#### Areas of Learning

<u>As writers</u> we will be studying different books and writing our own narrative from these as well as other genres. We will study author's skills and techniques and use this information to improve our own writing. We will focus on authorial intent and vocabulary choices as well as looking at how to create atmosphere through setting descriptions.

As Readers we will continue to read and discuss an increasingly wide range of fiction, poetry, plays, non-fiction and reference or text books and read books that are structured in different ways and read for a range of purposes. We will recommend books that we have read to our peers, giving reasons for our choices As scientists we will explain that unsupported objects fall towards the Earth because of the force of gravity acting between the Earth and the falling object. We will identify the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction, that act between moving surfaces. We will recognise that some mechanisms, including levers, pulleys and gears, allow a smaller force to have a greater effect.

#### Dear Parents,

The children worked very hard last half term and did some amazing learning! They have been using their BLPs and growth mindset to help them to achieve this. We are very much looking forward to learning new things this term.

#### Reading
