Making life affordable.

The Bread & Butter Thing is a charity that manages surplus food and recycles it back into the community. Weekly bags are made up and sold to families at very affordable prices. For £7.50 they offer food to the value of roughly £35.00, including fresh fruit and veg. They get their supplies from all the supermarkets, factories and farms that would otherwise be going to waste.

From next Friday families in our local area can access the new St George's Bread & Butter Hub at St George's church which will be open at 2pm each Friday. You must have ordered in advance.

To take advantage of the offer you must text them on 07860 063304 with your full name, postcode and the name of the hub you will collect from which for ours is HYDE. Select the size of order you would like from Family £7.50, Individual £4 or large family £15 (they do also offer a vegetarian option).

They will send you a text every Wednesday asking if you would like an order that week.

On Fridays you will collect from the church and pay in person then. Someone can collect on your behalf if you cannot make it.

Fun Friends & Fitness

Next week the whole school will be joining in a range of activities for Fun, Friends & Fitness week.

During this week we focus on health and wellbeing - in our bodies as well as our relationships. We will have Freddie Fit, the aerobics instructor on Tuesday and skipping workshops on Thursday. Each class will be doing different things during the week.

Word of the Week

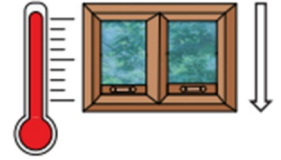
Word Aware
