Successful Learners Areas of Learning

<u>As geographers</u> we will be looking at international tourism, doing an indepth study of Spain. We will locate it on maps and look at its human and physical features.

<u>As scientists</u> we will be investigating electricity and working practically to design and make circuits.

<u>As mathematicians</u> we will complete our Multiplication Tables Check and learn how to tell the time. We will also learn about statistics and geometry.

<u>In PSHE</u> we will be looking at how to keep the body healthy and eating a well-balanced diet. We think of why it is important not to stereotype people when we consider travel and tourism.

In D&T we will be studying Spanish foods, Tapas. We will measure and weigh ingredients appropriately to prepare and cook a range of savoury dishes.
