We will compare and contrast this environment to where we live now. We will consider the main similarities and differences in the Physical and Human Geography between the UK and Bangladesh.</p> <p>As scientists we will be learning about living things including humans. We will consider what animals need in order to live and how we can stay healthy.</p> <p>As Mathematicians we will be learning to measure height, weight, length, capacity and temperature.
