Areas of Learning

<u>As Historians</u> we will be looking at the language of time. We will also be learning about ourselves and our own history and then asking questions about our parent's and grandparent's lives.

<u>As artists</u> we will try to create our own portraits and use these to add to our very own fact files about ourselves.

<u>As information technologists</u> we will learn how be safe whilst using the internet. We will also be using the Beebots in our learning.

As Musicians we will be

listening to different types of music and using adjectives to describe it and then to try to recreate our own.

In Religious Education we will be learning about the creation story and how God felt at various parts of the story. We will also look at Harvest and where our food comes from. We will also look at Fair Trade food.
