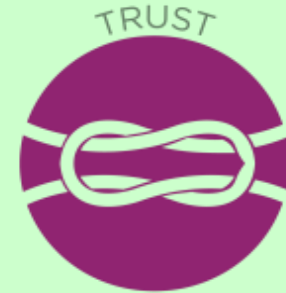

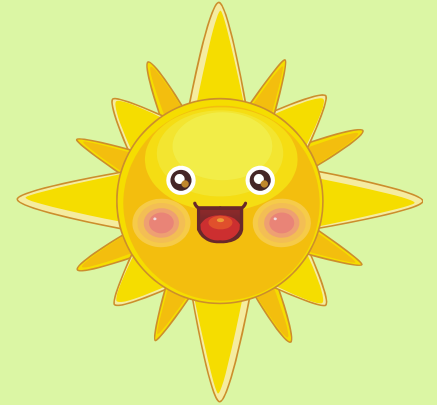
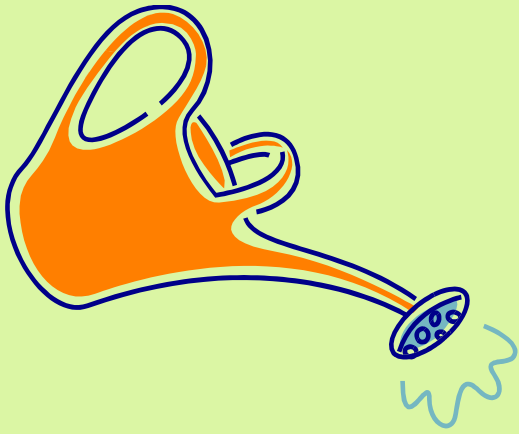

The Emperor's Seeds

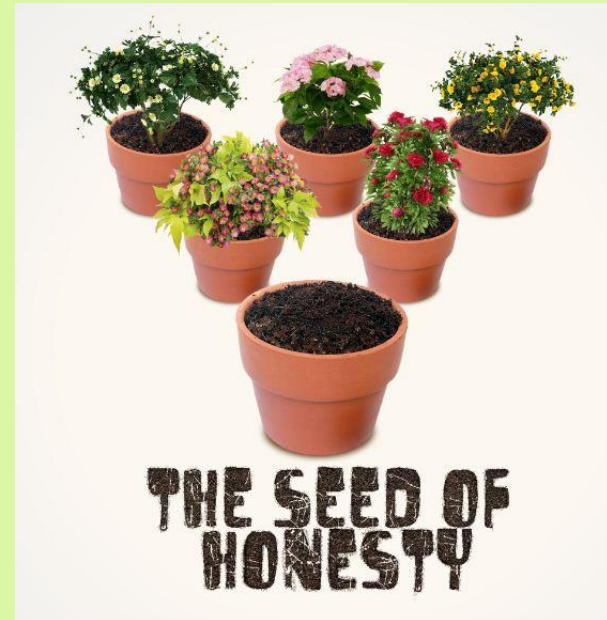


Reflecting

Prayer



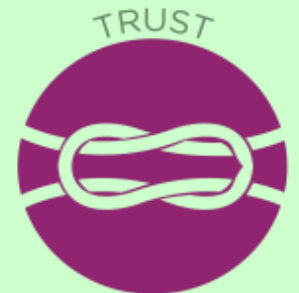
Dear God,

Amen.



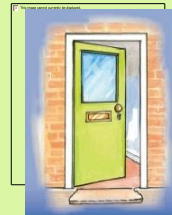
