Our school day starts at 8.40 am when the bell goes for lining up in the playground

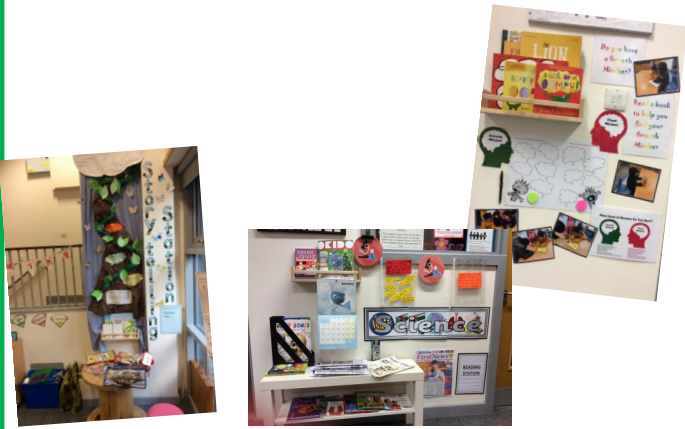


Reading Stations

Ask them what they have been reading !



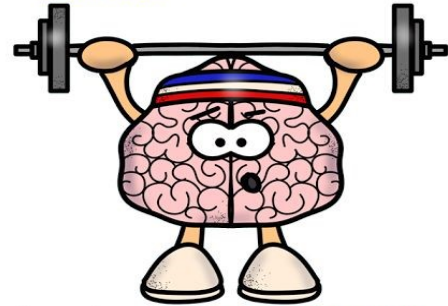
Parents workshops—Home Learning

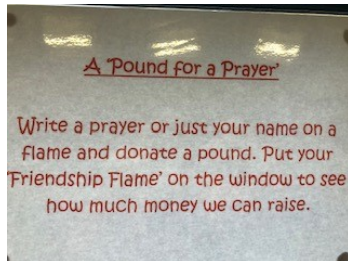
